









How to select the preferred State




How to view approvals from the State page


















How to submit the State Registration Form









Onward journey after State Registration Form submission

- On successful submission of the State Registration Form, the user's information and documents will be transferred to the concerned State Single Window System (SWS)
- User will then be immediately redirected to their Dashboard. The list of approvals on your NSWS Dashboard will now be open for application and the Apply Now button for the respective approvals will be enabled
- When user clicks on 'Apply Now' for any approval, user will be redirected to the respective State Single Window System and automatically logged in through Single Sign-On
 - Single sign-on (SSO) is a session and user authentication service that permits a user to use only one set of login credentials. In this case, user will only require their NSWS username and password
- Once logged into State Single Window System, the approvals selected by user on NSWS will display prominently in their user profile section
- User can also add or delete any approvals they prefer from the list in State SWS. The updated list of approvals will automatically sync with NSWS
- Now, user may apply for any of the approvals by filling the relevant information/ documents in State SWS. Their previously uploaded documents in NSWS will also be available in state SWS for the user's convenience
- Once user has submitted the selected approval's application, they will be redirected to the NSWS portal
- On their NSWS Dashboard's 'State Related Approvals' section, the respective approval's application status will show as 'In Progress'
- The concerned approval's progression status will periodically update on user's NSWS Dashboard
- Once user's application is approved or rejected, the same will display on NSWS
- If application has been approved, the 'Approval Certificate' can be viewed and downloaded from 'My Documents' section









What are the technical Requirements for NSWS

System Requirements for National Single Window Portal

- Windows OS (XP or higher)
- MAC OS (X 10.9 or higher with latest updates)
- View/ Download Pdf: Download the pdf reader to view and download the pdf files from the link: https://get.adobe.com/reader/)
- Platform requires a minimum screen size of 976px wide, but using 1024px or higher is recommended
- Digital Signature Certificate (DSC): Latest version of emBridge software need to be installed in the system which acts a connecting link/driver between the NSWS and DSC
